

**GUIDELINES: PHYTOSANITARY REQUIREMENTS AND WORKING
PROCEDURES FOR EXPORT OF GRAPES FROM S.A.
TO TAIWAN**

1. Commodities of Grapes allowed

- All grape spp.

2. Export regions

- All provinces of SA.

3. Critical quarantine pests

Ceratitis capitata – Mediterranean fruit fly

Ceratitis rosa – Natal fruit fly

Frankinella occidentalis - Western flower thrips

**4. Phytosanitary registration requirements with the Department of
Agriculture; Forestry & Fisheries (DAFF)**

- No annual registration and approval for this market

5. Marking requirements

5.1 Cartons

- The following information must be on the business end of each carton
 - PUC code
 - Date code
 - "To Taiwan Republic of China"

6. Consignment size

- No restriction on consignments size
- High cube pallets must be packed at the pack house
- Note: FPT Durban is not equipped to handle high cube pallets.

Sampling procedures

A 2% sample will be drawn randomly per pallet at the phytosanitary inspection point.

Documentation

**Original sample accompanying document
Original intake documents (consignment notes)**

7. Rejection principles

- **Consignments will be rejected if any pests of quarantine importance on the Taiwan Directive are found during the phytosanitary inspection**

8. Shipping requirements

- **Cold treatment conducted in-transit with the pulp temperature at 3.33 degrees C for 18 days. There are other options available on request**

9. Phytosanitary certificate

- **A phytosanitary certificate will be issued with an additional declaration:**
- **The fruit has been thoroughly inspected and found free from Ceratitis capitata and Frankliniella occidentalis**
- **Date: Indicate date of commencement of cold treatment as per PPECB certificate**
- **Treatment: In – transit cold treatment**
- **Duration and Temp: Indicate details as per PPECB pre – cooling certificate**
- **An in-transit cold treatment certificate issued by PPECB will be attached as an addendum to the phytosanitary certificate**
