**AMENDMENT OF DISPENSATION: EXPORT OF EXTRA CLASS, CLASS 1 AND CLASS 2, WITH TWO TO THREE VARIETIES OF TABLE GRAPES PACKED IN COMPOSITE PUNNETS TO ALL DESTINATIONS
[ALL PRODUCERS AND EXPORTERS]**

The above subject bears reference.

Paragraph 1 of the dispensation granted on the 14th of October 2011 with the Serial No. 12/10/11/01 is hereby amended and the amendment is as follows:

“Permission is hereby granted by the Executive Officer: Agricultural Product Standards in terms of section 4 (4) of the Agricultural Product Standards Act, 1990 (Act No. 119 of 1990), to All Producers and Exporters to export Extra Class, Class 1 and Class 2, with two to four varieties of table grapes, packed in composite punnets of various sizes to all destinations. Provided that “Varieties” and the word “Mixed Varieties” will be indicated on the cartons and inspection procedures should be adhered to. The fruit originates from all production areas in the Republic of South Africa.”

Please note that this amendment is subject to the conditions as set out in the previous dispensation.
